Welcome First Grade Families!

We are setting GOALS in First Grade! Here are some things to help you and your students have a successful year in first grade.

GOAL 1: Read a DRA Level 16-18 by the end of the school year. Make sure you complete that reading log each week for homework!

A DRA level 16 reader can read fluently while self-correcting errors, and de-coding unknown words. They can re-tell a story starting from the beginning and include all the important details. A level 16 reader can make predictions about what they think will happen next in the story and make a text to self-connection.

GOAL 2: Pass all 20-word lists by the end of the school year (meet smaller quarterly goals too!)

Q1 Lists 1-6 Q2 Lists 7-11 Q3 Lists 12-15 Q4 Lists 16-20

GOAL 3: Pass Math Facts in 3 min. per worksheet side (addition and subtraction 60 equations) you can download and print practice sheets under "Parent and Teacher Resources."

GOAL 4: Write 5-6 complete sentences on a given topic. Use proper punctuation and capitalization.

GOAL 5: Complete iReady lessons completed weekly (1 Reading lesson and 1 Math lesson)
